- b. Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax Clearance Certificates of all the Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2021;
- c. Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;
- d. Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021:
- e. Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2021;
- f. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2021 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- g. Sworn Affidavit:
 - disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Federal Medical Centre, Makurdi or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars;

- h. Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2018, 2019 & 2020;
- Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank in Nigeria, indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- j. Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications;
- k. Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- 1. Category B: Evidence of Practice License issued by relevant regulatory professional body(ies);
- m. Only companies included in the National Automotive Design and Development Council's approved list of local manufacturers of vehicles or their authorised representatives should bid for the vehicles;
- n. Lot A2: Letter of Authorization as representative of the Original Equipment Manufacturers (OEMs);
- o. For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner)
- i. All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), Contact Address, Telephone Number (preferably GSM No.), and e-mail address. The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

4. COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS (CATEGORY A)

Interested companies are to collect the Standard Bidding Document (SBD) from the office of the Head of Procurement on evidence of payment of a non-refundable tender fee of **N10,000.00** per Lot, paid into the Federal Medical Centre Makurdi's Remita account in any reputable commercial bank in Nigeria. Receipt will be tendered on submission of Tender documents Interested firms in Category B will not pay at this stage until after shortlisting.

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5. SUBMISSION OF TENDER DOCUMENTS (CATEGORY A)

Prospective bidders are to submit two (2) hard copies, one copy of technical and one copy of financial bid with soft copy of financial bids only in MS EXCEL format packaged separately in sealed envelopes and clearly marked as "Technical Bid" or "Financial Bid". Thereafter put the two sealed envelopes together in a bigger sealed envelope addressed to the **Medical Director**, **Federal Medical Centre**, **Makurdi**, **No.1 Atiku Abubakar Road**, **Old G.R.A**, **PMB 102004 Makurdi**, **Benue State** and clearly marked with the name of the project and Lot number. Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should bear the names and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender Proof box at the above address not later than **12:00 noon on Thursday**, **4**th **March**, **2021**.

6. SUBMISSION OF EOI DOCUMENTS (CATEGORY B)

Interested firms are to submit two (2) bound of Expression of Interest (EoI) documents separated by dividers and arranged as indicated above. The documents should be submitted in a sealed envelope and addressed as stated above, and clearly marked with (*the name of the project and the Lot number*). Furthermore, the reverse of each sealed envelope should bear the name and address of the bidder and drop in the designated Tender Box not later than 12:00 noon on Tuesday, 2nd March, 2021.

7. OPENING OF EOI AND TECHNICAL BIDS

The EOI and Technical Bids will be opened immediately after the deadlines for submission at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, 2nd March, 2021 and 12:00 noon on Thursday, 4th March, 2021

respectively in the **Board Room of Federal Medical Centre**, **Makurdi**, while the financial bids will be kept unopened. Bidders are to sign the bid submission register in the office of the Medical Director, Federal Medical Centre, Makurdi (Mission Ward). 8. GENERAL INFORMATION

- i. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorised by the bidder;
- ii. Bids submitted after the deadline for submission would be returned un-opened;
- iii. Bidders should not bid for more than one (1) Lot;
- iv. All costs will be borne by the bidders;
- v. Presence of bidders/representatives and members of the public shall not be required during the bid opening ceremony in compliance with COVID-19 Guidelines. The Bids Opening will be covered by video recording with the presence of two (2) representatives of private sector professional bodies and Civil Society Organisation in the areas of Anti-Corruption/Transparency;
