## <u>Bureau of Public Procurement and Defence Headquarters</u> <u>Collaborates to develop a capacity building and Certification Policy</u> for the Military

The Director General, Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) Mamman Ahmadu FNIQS, said the office is collaborating on developing a capacity building and certification policy on a standardized procurement cadre for the Three Arms of the Defence.

The DG said this during the inauguration of a Joint Technical Committee on Proposed Defence Procurement Certification Policy, which took place in the Conference Room of the BPP

The Technical Committee between the BPP and the Defence Office aims at developing a Procurement Cadre Policy for the Defence sector, to harmonize training modules for the Defence sector and to assist in setting up a certification policy for the three arms of the military amongst others.

The Technical Committee were given a time line of four (4) weeks to submit their report.
