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FG COMMISSIONS NEW WATER PROJECTS IN RIVERS STATE



The Federal Government's commitment to the full implementation of the recommendations of the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) on Ogoni Environment, specifically for the provision of potable water to communities, gained a boost recently following the commissioning of new water projects in four Ogoni communities in Rivers State. The water projects are located in Bodo (Gokana LGA), Eteo (Eleme LGA), Uegwere-Boue and Taabaa communities (both in Khana LGA) respectively. The projects were completed by the Hydrocarbon Pollution Remediation Project (HYPREP). The Minister of Environment, Malam Balarabe Abbas Lawal, in company of the Chairman of HYPREP Governing Council and several other dignitaries commissioned the water projects. The Minister also commissioned the Gokana Area Office, an initiative of HYPREP, to foster Project-Community relationships and he presented cooking stoves to beneficiaries of a programme aimed at reducing dependence on mangroves for firewood. He also visited the Centre of Excellence for Environmental Restoration (CEER). While speaking at the ceremony in Bodo, Gokana Local Government Area, the Minister described the development as a major step in Federal Government's resolve to restore the dignity of the Ogoni people after decades of environmental degradation from oil pollution. He urged the communities to work with HYPREP, own and safeguard the facilities against vandalism, noting that the sustainability of the projects begins with community stewardship. The Minister reaffirmed the Federal Government's commitment to the full implementation of the UNEP Report and the need to correct historical wrongs and deliver genuine remediation and sustainable development to Ogoni land. He also explained that the actualisation of the projects attests to stakeholders' collaboration and collective resolve, adding that the projects symbolise hope, equity and justice for communities that have long endured the consequences of environmental degradation. The Minister further stated that access to clean and safe water is essential to basic human rights and that the commissioning of the water projects reaffirms government's unwavering commitment to upholding human rights. He acknowledged the contributions of traditional and youth leaders, NGOs and Renaissance/JV partners in the success of the projects. With the latest commissioning, HYPREP is now providing potable water to 40 communities and hopes to cover more by end of the year.

RE: TRANSITION TO ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION PROCEDURES AT THE BUREAU OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT (BPP)

Further to the Bureau's Circular referenced BPP/DG/ 2025/250 of 4th August, 2025 on the above subject matter, and in view of the ongoing migration to e-government platforms, the deadline for exclusive electronic submission of all requests and documents to the BPP is hereby extended to Monday, 8th September, 2025.

2. In view of the above, the Bureau wishes to notify all Government Ministries, Departments, and Agencies (MDAs), Government Owned Companies (GOCs), Private Companies/Firms, and Non – Governmental Organizations(NGOs)/ Civil Society Organizations(CSOs) of the following:

i. With effect from Tuesday, 9th September, 2025, the Bureau will not accept or process any hardcopy requests/submissions. MDAs, GOCs, Private Companies/Firms and NGOs/CSOs shall continue to submit all procurement-related documents electronically via submissions@bpp.gov.ng (all routine procurement submissions), and receive BPP correspondences via official@bpp.gov.ng;

ii. All non-procurement related communications and inquiries shall be submitted via the Bureau's official

email: info@bpp.gov.ng;

iii. Failure to adhere to the new deadline and channels of communication shall result in outright denial of service by the Bureau, including non-acceptance and non-processing of requests/submissions until the concerned MDA or Organization fully complies with the electronic submission procedures;

iv. MDAs or Organizations that have not already done so are to forward two (2) official email addresses and two (2) active telephone numbers of designated officers for formal communication and authentication purposes.

3. All MDAs, GOCs, Private Companies/Firms and NGOs/CSOs are enjoined to ensure immediate alignment of their internal processes to avoid disruptions or delays in procurement submissions and reviews.

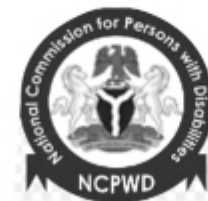
